**NOTICE OF CONDUCT OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.1 (TWO
FAILED BIDDINGS) FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES FOR THE
CONSULATE ON VIALE STELVIO**

1. The Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), through its Bids and Awards Committee, will conduct a negotiated procurement, after two consecutive failed biddings, pursuant to Section 53.1 of the revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, for the procurement of the **Security Services for the Consulate on Viale Stelvio** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of **Eighty Six Thousand Euros (€86,000.00)** or **Ninety Five Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Five US Dollars (\$95,555.00)** only.
2. Interested/invited bidders may submit their offers (in sealed envelopes) for negotiation to the Bids and Awards Committee Secretariat of the Philippine Consulate in Via Stromboli 1, Milan, on or before 14 December 2017, at 12:00 p.m. No submissions shall be accepted after this hour. Offers should, in no case, exceed the ABC (€86,000.00) for the project. Individual negotiations with participating bidders will commence on the same date, at 2:00 p.m., in the order of their submissions.
3. After the initial negotiations, the interested/invited bidders shall submit their **Best and Final Offer** (in a sealed envelope) to the Bids and Awards Committee Secretariat of the Philippine Consulate in Via Stromboli 1, Milan on or before 22 December 2017, at 12:00 p.m. Opening of sealed envelopes shall be on the same date at 2:00 p.m., in the same order as the submission of the initial offer. No submissions shall be accepted after this hour.
4. The Technical Specifications for the procurement contract are attached under Annex "A."
5. The successful offer shall be selected on the basis of the compliance with the Technical Specifications and the best and final offer.
6. The Philippine Consulate reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the negotiation process, and to reject all offers at any time prior to contract award, without incurring any liability to the affected participants.

Technical Specifications

Item	Specification	Statement of Compliance
1.	The contractor shall be a corporation or company duly organized and existing under Italian laws. It must be duly licensed by appropriate government authorities to render security and related services.	
2.	The contractor must be capable of rendering security services to the whole premises of the Consulate General of the Republic of the Philippine including Office building, Consular Area, and inside and outside area of the perimeter wall.	
3.	The contractor shall provide its security and safety guards with proper uniforms and paraphernalia including identification cards countersigned by the company's representative in order to distinguish them from the Consulate's personnel or other groups in the Consulate.	
4.	The contractor shall conduct, at least once every three (3) months, its own unit training drills involving all the emergency procedures (fire-fighting, first aid and medical evacuation, earthquake drill and evacuation, search and rescue operations and crowd disturbance management). The drill shall be evaluated by the Consul General or her designated representative.	
5.	The contractor shall provide security services to the Consulate from Mondays to Fridays on a 12 hour basis, 8:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m.
