



NOTICE OF CONDUCT OF NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER SECTION 53.1 (TWO FAILED BIDDINGS) FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF THE PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF MOVERS FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE CONSULATE FROM STROMBOLI TO STELVIO

1. The Philippine Consulate General (PCG) in Milan, through its Bids and Awards Committee, will conduct negotiated procurement, after two consecutive failed biddings, pursuant to Section 53.1 of the revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, for the Procurement of Services of Movers for the Transfer of the Consulate from Stomboli to Stelvio with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of One Million One Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Pesos (Php. 1,139,713.00) only.
2. Interested/invited bidders may submit their offers for negotiation to the Bids and Awards Committee Secretariat at Philippine Consulate General, Via Stromboli 1, 20144 Milan, Italy, on or before **18 October 2017, at 12:00noon**. No submissions shall be accepted after this hour. Offers should, in no case, exceed the ABC One Million One Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Pesos for the project. Individual negotiations with the participating bidders will commence on the same date, at 1pm, in the order of their submissions.
3. After the initial negotiations, the interested/invited bidders shall submit their Best and Final Offer to the Bids and Awards Committee Secretariat at Philippine Consulate General, Via Stromboli 1, 20144 Milan, Italy, on or before **20 October 2017, at 12:00noon**. No submissions shall be accepted after this hour.
4. The Terms of Reference for the procurement contract are attached under **Annex "A"**.
5. The successful offer shall be selected on the basis of the compliance with the Terms of Reference and the best and final offer.
6. The Philippine Consulate General (PCG) reserves the right to accept or reject any offer, to annul the negotiation process, and to reject all offers at any time prior to contract award, without incurring any liability to the affected participants.

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TERMS OF REFERENCE
PROCUREMENT OF SERVICES OF MOVERS FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE CONSULATE
FROM STROMBOLI TO STELVIO

I. ITEM FOR PROCUREMENT

Services of Movers for the Transfer of the Consulate from Stromboli to Stelvio.

II. APPROVED BUDGET FOR THE CONTRACT

One Million One Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Pesos (Php. 1,139,713.00) at Php. 61.00 per 1€

III. BASIC TERM

The term of contract shall be for a period of one (1) month.

IV. MODE OF PAYMENT

Bank Transfer

V. REQUIREMENTS

1. Door-to-door delivery from Via Stromboli 1, 20144 Milan, Italy to Viale Stelvio 71 - Via Bernina 18, 20159 Milan, Italy.
2. Supply of brand new packing materials.
3. Full packing of files, computers, other electronic equipment, vaults and cabinets.
4. All boxes to be moved shall be numbered and inventoried with labels.
5. Packing of computers and other electronic equipment shall be with rubber-pad blankets for protection.
6. Careful packing, loading and unpacking shall be done by experienced crews.
7. Unloading and placement per agreed layout.
8. Packing and transport of coffee table and office chair from Consulate (Via Stromboli 1, Milan, Italy) to Official Residence (Via Alberto da Giussano 17, Milan, Italy)
9. Removal of packing debris from site.
10. The transfer of all the documents and equipment shall be done for a maximum of three (3) days.

VI. INCLUSIONS

1. All-risk door-to-door transport insurance coverage.
2. Parking/access and other necessary permits.
3. Long carry, stair carry and hoisting/outside elevator.
4. Pickup and delivery shall be done from basement up to the 4th floor.
